DECISIONS

The Süleyman Demirel University Education Program Evaluation Board (SDÜTF-EPDK) convened on 15 March 2018 in Meeting Hall A of the Dean's Office Building under the chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Rengin ELSÜRER AFŞAR, with the participation of the majority of board members. At the meeting, it was decided that:

1. A presentation was given by the Term 3 Coordinator, Assist. Prof. Dr. M. Cem ŞİRİN, regarding the updated draft Term 3 curriculum.
2. Faculty members be assigned from the relevant departments for the Teaching Skills courses planned to be held in Term 3.
3. The Nuclear Medicine courses be moved from Term 3 to Term 5.
4. The Biostatistics course hours remain the same, but it be considered appropriate to open Special Study Modules (ÖÇM) related to the topics intended to be covered.
5. The Biostatistics course topics be reviewed.
6. The course on the Autonomic Nervous System, and Sympathomimetic and Parasympathomimetic Drugs, be moved to Committee II, after the Introduction to Pharmacology.
7. The course sequencing within the Term 3 Committees was updated, and the Professional Skills Applications course was added to Wednesdays.
8. The Term 3 Committees would be structured as 6, 6, 6, 5, 5, 7 weeks respectively.
9. In Committee I (Tissue Injury and Infection), the lecture order be Pathology, Pharmacology, Virology, and Mycology.
10. The title of the Hemodynamic Disorders course taught by Pathology be reviewed.
11. The Department of Pharmacology's requests for a total of 8 additional course hours for new course proposals under 6 headings be evaluated.
12. In Committee II, the course title "Respiratory System Examination" be changed to "Respiratory System Semiology."
13. The "Drugs Used in Cardiology" heading of the Cardiology course taught in Week 4 of Committee II be reviewed.
14. The Heart Failure and Arrhythmias course be added to Cardiology.
15. The number of ECG lectures be increased.
16. A lecture on childhood diarrhea (1 hour) be added to the Pediatrics courses in Committee III.
17. A lecture on malabsorption be added to Pediatrics (2 hours).
18. The opinion of the Department of Pediatrics be obtained regarding topics that need to be moved to Term 3.
19. The "Introduction to GIS Radiology" course be moved from Committee II to Committee III, and the Antiprotozoal and Antimalarial Drugs (Pharmacology) course be moved from Committee I to Committee III.
20. The Abdominal Wall Hernias (General Surgery) course be moved to Committee III.
21. The Pathology practicals be distributed throughout the committee rather than being held consecutively.
22. Committee IV's Internal Medicine sequence begin with Nephrology and Urology, and the Hypertension course be moved to Committee II.
23. The Diabetic Nephropathy course be added in Committee IV immediately after the Diabetes course.

24. The Organ Transplantation and Donation integrated session be removed from Committee IV and moved to Committee I, and, in its place, the Sexually Transmitted Diseases integrated session be added to Committee IV.
25. The Renal Function Tests course in Committee IV be taught jointly by Biochemistry and Nephrology.
26. The Pathology course in Committee IV be renamed "Pathology of Glomerular Diseases."
27. The Department of Psychiatry be consulted regarding the title and scope of the integrated session on "Mental Health Problems in Students" to be added to Committee V.
28. The title of Committee V be set as "Neurological Sciences, Psychiatry and the Musculoskeletal System."
29. How Assessment and Evaluation would be conducted in clinical education was raised, along with organizing a Clinical Assessment Course for faculty members. It was decided that a scoring system based on Professional Skills Training be introduced for clinical education practices and that this be added to the committee examination grade; that at least 80% attendance be required for the score to be added; and that a form be created for this purpose.
30. The "Elementary Skin Lesions" course be moved from Committee II to Committee V.
31. The relevant department be consulted regarding teaching the Biostatistics courses together in Committee VI.
32. The relevant department be consulted as to whether a practical course should be added to Family Medicine.
33. A comprehensive session on topics such as "smoking and smoking cessation methods" be added to Committee VI's program, to be covered over 1 day and addressed in detail by faculty members from different departments.
34. The relevant departments be consulted regarding the Cardiology- and Pediatrics-related topics considered for addition to Term 3 (heart failure, arrhythmia, diarrhea in pediatrics).
35. The Chairs of the Departments of Biostatistics, Medical Genetics, Physiology, Cardiology and Pediatrics be invited to the next meeting, with the Preclinical and Clinical Departments invited separately.
