DECISIONS

The Süleyman Demirel University Education Program Evaluation Board (SDÜTF-EPDK) convened on 3 April 2018 in Meeting Hall A of the Dean's Office Building under the chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Rengin ELSÜRER AFŞAR, with the participation of the majority of board members. At the meeting, it was agreed that:

1. Biostatistics be included as a course in Terms 1, 3, 4 and 5; however, in Years 1, 4 and 5 it be given within Evidence-Based Medicine, while in Term 3 it be given as a separate Biostatistics course; and that in Term 2, instead of an Evidence-Based Medicine practice session, a Special Study Module (ÖÇM) on Biostatistics be opened.
2. In the Term 1 curriculum, the Biostatistics course be taught for 6 hours within Evidence-Based Medicine, and in Term 3 for 30 hours.
3. The Biostatistics course topics be reorganized.
4. The Evidence-Based Medicine course needs to be taught throughout all 6 years.
5. In Evidence-Based Medicine education, since Selçuk University holds a one-day session on preparing posters, case presentations, and smoking-related education, it be considered whether such a practice could also be implemented here in Term 3.
6. Regarding the course given online by the Rectorate under the name Basic Information Technologies, the faculty members of our Faculty's Department of Medical Informatics wish to conduct it themselves by dividing students into groups, and this matter is to be discussed with the Rectorate.
7. Since the Department of Medical Genetics currently teaches 18 hours of lectures in Year 3 and wishes to increase this to 36 hours, given that Term 1 has 20 hours of related lectures, the Medical Genetics course hours in Year 3 be set at 24 hours.
8. The Department of Physiology stated that it wishes to teach, in Term 3, the lectures removed from Term 2 as pathophysiology; however, since Term 3 is planned to be more clinically oriented, Physiology lectures are not very suitable for Year 3.
9. For the reasons stated in Article 8, the Physiology lectures could be added to Term 3 integrated sessions, or 6 hours could be added to Term 2.
10. The Cardiology course topics taught in Year 3, Committee 2 were evaluated by the department's faculty members; it was stated that, since the ECG lecture needs to be conducted with practice, it would be appropriate for only 1 hour to remain, and that this would be more efficient with practical applications in Years 4 and 5. The topics "Arrhythmia" (1 hour), "Approach to the Patient Presenting with Chest Pain" (1 hour), and "Approach to the Patient Presenting with Shortness of Breath" (1 hour) be added to the program, and the lecture on drugs used in heart failure be removed.
11. The Department of Pediatrics' request for 6 hours of practical application in Year 3 was discussed.
12. It was agreed that the next meeting would be held at the same place on 16 April 2018 at 14:00.
