DECISIONS

The Süleyman Demirel University Education Program Evaluation Board (SDÜTF-EPDK) convened on 2 July 2019 in Meeting Room A of the Dean's Office Building under the chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Ersin USKUN, with the participation of the majority of the board members. At the meeting:

1. It was decided that course programs and faculty member assignments would be requested from the departments for the 2019-2020 Academic Year.
2. It was decided that the clerkship guides for Term 4, Term 5 and Term 6 would be renewed for the 2019-2020 Academic Year and sent to the EPDK through the Coordinators' Offices.
3. It was decided that, at the start of the 2019-2020 Academic Year, a conference on the topic "What Kind of Physician Do We Aim to Train?" would be organized to raise faculty members' awareness, and that a senior Medical Education instructor from outside the province would be invited to this conference.
4. The decisions taken at meetings held with the chairs of the departments offering courses in Term 1, Term 2 and Term 3, the Chief Coordinator, the Chair of the EPDK Board, the faculty members of the Department of Medical Education, and the relevant Term Coordinators, as set out below, were shared with the board members, and it was decided unanimously.

EDUCATION REVISION

1. Regarding the "Being a Good Physician" course held during orientation week, it was decided that Prof. Dr. A. Rifat ÖRMECİ, Prof. Dr. Erdoğan İBRİŞİM, Prof. Dr. Serhat GÜRPINAR and Prof. Dr. A. Nesimi KİŞİOĞLU would be consulted to teach the course in place of the retired Prof. Dr. Mahmut BÜLBÜL.
2. It was decided that the 2-hour "Assisted Reproductive Techniques" course in Term 1, Course Committee 4 would, for topic continuity, be moved to after the infertility course in Term 3, Course Committee 4.
3. It was decided that the titles of the 8-hour "Basic Concepts in Organic Chemistry" courses in Term 1, Course Committee 1 would be revised by the Department of Medical Biochemistry.
4. It was decided that an integrated session on "Intercellular Signal Transmission", to be presented by the Departments of Physiology, Biophysics and Medical Biochemistry, would be added to Term 1, Course Committee 3.
5. It was decided that short video lessons would be prepared by the Department of Anatomy, to be shown to students before the Professional Skills courses "Venous Blood Sampling", "Blood Pressure Measurement" and "IM Injection" included in Term 1.
6. It was decided that the Department of General Surgery would be consulted regarding the addition of presentations on "Topographic Anatomy and Radiology of the Abdomen" by the Departments of Radiology and Anatomy, before the Term 4 General Surgery clerkship, in order to help students adapt to clinical examination methods and to support vertical integration.
7. It was decided that the relevant departments would be consulted regarding the addition of presentations on "Topographic Anatomy and Radiology of the Thorax" before the Thoracic Surgery / Chest Diseases clerkship.
8. It was decided that, because the existing courses for "Introduction to Physiology" were insufficient, the existing 2-hour course in Term 2, Course Committee 1 would be increased to 4 hours.
9. It was decided that the Department of Medical Biochemistry's course "Muscle Types and Contraction Mechanisms" in Term 2, Course Committee 1 would be renamed "Muscle Tissue Proteins and Their Functions", on the grounds that this title better matches the learning objectives.

10. It was decided that, for the same reason, the course "Adipose Tissue Biochemistry" would be renamed "Adipose Tissue as an Endocrine Organ: Part 1".
11. It was decided that, because the Biophysics course titles contained repetitions and some course content was considered to be covered by other departments (Biochemistry, Physiology, etc.), the Department of Biophysics would submit the hours, content and course materials of its courses to the EPDK.
12. It was decided that the free hours included in the Term 1 program would be distributed evenly across the week.
13. It was decided that the 2-hour course "Vaccines", taught by the Department of Pediatrics in Term 3, Course Committee 1, would be moved to Year 4 and given as the course "Prematurity" in Term 3, Course Committee 4.
14. It was decided that, for the 2018-2019 academic year, 4 of the 8 hours of the Department of Nuclear Medicine's course in Term 3, Course Committee 1 would be transferred to the Department of Radiation Oncology, with the topics to be determined accordingly.
15. It was decided that the integrated sessions would remain the same.
16. It was decided that the Department of Pediatrics' courses "Von Willebrand Disease", "Immune Thrombocytopenic Purpura" and "Lymphomas" (3 hours), in Term 3, Course Committee 2, would be moved to Year 4, and that the courses "Hemoglobinopathies", "Head and Neck Examination" and "Approach to Anemia in Childhood" would be added in their place.
17. It was decided that the Department of Dermatology would also be included in the integrated session on "Sexually Transmitted Diseases" in Term 3, Course Committee 4.
18. It was decided that, in place of the 1-hour course "Common Syndromes in Pediatric Endocrinology" taught by the Department of Pediatrics in Term 3, Course Committee 4, the course "Prematurity" would be given.
19. It was decided that the courses "Approach to the Child with Ambiguous Genitalia" and "Growth and Growth Disorders" would be changed to "Obesity" and "Rickets".
20. It was decided that the Department of Pediatrics' course titled "Neurometabolic Syndrome" in Term 3, Course Committee 5 would be changed to "Meningococemia".
21. It was decided that the Department of Medical Biochemistry's course "Bone Turnover Markers" in Term 3, Course Committee 5 would be increased from 1 hour to 2 hours, as it could not be adequately covered in 1 hour.
22. It was decided that the "Urine Microscopy" practical course taught by the Department of Medical Biochemistry in Term 3, Course Committee 4 would be given as a professional skills course.
23. It was decided that, among the skills envisaged to be acquired under the National Core Curriculum (UÇEP), the "Lumbar Puncture" skill would be added to Term 3, Course Committee 4 as a professional skills course.
24. It was decided that the 2-hour courses taught by the Department of Public Health in Term 3, Course Committee 6 — "Introduction to Communicable Disease Epidemiology, Basic Concepts", "Control of Communicable Diseases by Route of Transmission", "Air Pollution", "Environmental Health", "Adequate and Balanced Nutrition", "Smoking from the Perspective of Public Health" and "Introduction to Occupational Health, Application Principles" — would be reduced to 1 hour each, that the 3-hour course "Occupational Diseases and Prevention" would be reduced to 2 hours, and that the following courses would be added to Term 3, Course Committee 6, amounting to 10 hours in place of the reduced 8 hours: School Health (1 hour), Drinking and Utility Water (2 hours), Solid Waste and Its Disposal (2 hours), Other Factors Affecting Health (1 hour), Occupational Health Application Principles (2 hours), Occupational Health Problems in Developing Countries (1 hour), Occupational Health Epidemiology (1 hour), and Occupational Risks of Health Syndromes (1 hour).
25. It was decided that the courses "Community Oral and Dental Health Problems" and "Health Tourism and Tourist Health", which are included in the National Core Curriculum (UÇEP) but not in the theoretical course program, would be added to Term 3, Course Committee 6.
26. It was decided that a 2-hour theoretical course on "Resuscitation", to be taught by the Department of Anesthesiology and Reanimation, would be added to Term 3, Course Committee 5, and that this course would be held before the corresponding professional skills practice session.

27. It was decided that a panel or integrated session on "Immunization, Community Immunity and Vaccine Refusal" would be held in Term 3, Course Committee 6, with the participation of the Departments of Public Health, Clinical Microbiology and Infectious Diseases, and Pediatrics.

28. It was decided that the 2-hour course "Assisted Reproductive Techniques", taught by Assist. Prof. Dr. Dilek ULUSOY KARATOPUK in Term 1, Course Committee 4, would, for topic continuity, be moved to Term 3, Course Committee 4.
