DECISIONS

The Süleyman Demirel University Education Program Evaluation Board (SDÜTF-EPDK) convened on 5 February 2020 in Meeting Room B of the Dean's Office Building under the chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Ersin USKUN. At the meeting:

1. Within the scope of expanding learner-centered activities in Phase 2 and 3, it was decided that ward visits and the parts of the program classified as practical application need to be structured. In this context, in order to serve as a model, the structuring of practical applications at Ege University Faculty of Medicine will be reviewed and presented as an example.
2. While course programs are discussed with departments for the purpose of horizontal integration in Phase 2 and 3 (particularly in the Department of Internal Medicine), it will be ensured that related topics are presented together in the same week.
3. In order to better assess learner-centered activities, the clerkship logbook used in the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PMR) will be examined and shown as an example to other departments.
4. In order to strengthen the Evidence-Based Medicine Practices (EBM) corridor, brief information about EBM practice will be given to departments while their programs are being discussed.
5. In order to place EBM practices into the program in Term 4, the hours between 15:00 and 17:00 every Thursday during the academic term will be left free, and into this time slot, activities on topics such as EBM practice as a priority, informing students about the electronic patient information management system, occupational health and safety, and project preparation will be scheduled together with the Term 4 Coordinator's Office.
6. It will be ensured that structured independent study hours are included in the program and structured. It was concluded that structured independent study hours and clinical practices such as ward visits could be included in the program on a rotating basis.
