Meeting Minutes

DECISIONS

The Süleyman Demirel University Education Program Evaluation Board (SDÜTF-EPDK) convened on 12 February 2020 in Meeting Room B of the Dean's Office Building under the chairmanship of Prof. Dr. Ersin USKUN, with the participation of board members and faculty members of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology. At the meeting:

1. It was discussed that there is no Evidence-Based Medicine application in the program and that one should be added. It was stated that an evidence-based medicine application could be added on the subjects of Family Planning and Urinary System Infections.
2. It was discussed that, unfortunately, cooperation could not be established with the Provincial Health Directorate for Community-Based Education, and that for this reason students are unable to participate in births and similar procedures at another institution in the field. It was stated that a birth simulation model is needed for use in the Clinical Skills Lectures.
3. It was stated that students coming to the clerkship are divided into 7 groups and that each group works with one faculty member until the end of the clerkship. Information was received that students who wish may attend the journal-article hour. It was agreed that it would be appropriate for these practices to be explained in detail in the clerkship guide.
4. It was agreed that it would be appropriate for the learning-objective levels of the lectures included in the clerkship guide to be reviewed again by the department, and for changes among faculty members to also be updated in the course schedule/guide.
5. It was agreed that, in order to achieve horizontal integration in the program, related lectures should be reviewed again and ordered in the program from general to specific in a way that provides coherence.
6. It was discussed that, as a learner-centered activity, a TASK-based pilot application planned by Prof. Dr. Mekin Sezik is intended to be included in the program, and that if successful, it would be extended more broadly.
7. It was reported that space could be opened in the program for Thursday 15:00-17:00, planned to be allocated as a coordination hour, but that Wednesday would not be suitable.
8. It was discussed that a skills-application exercise in the form of speculum insertion and smear collection could be added to the program, so that this practice, carried out in the presence of a faculty member, would be evaluated with a certain contribution to the examination. The department's view was reported that they could add such a practice.

PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT RECOMMENDATION

1. It would be appropriate to add an Evidence-Based Medicine Application on the subjects of Family Planning and Urinary System Infections to the program and to include it in the clerkship guide.
2. It would be appropriate to structure the practices within the clerkship. For example, it would be fitting to explain in detail in the clerkship guide how many groups the students coming to the clerkship are divided into, that each group works with one faculty member until the end of the clerkship, that students who wish attend the journal-article hour, etc.
3. It would be appropriate for the learning-objective levels of the lectures included in the clerkship guide to be reviewed again by the department, and for changes among faculty members to also be updated in the course schedule/guide.
4. It would be appropriate for related lectures to be reviewed again and ordered in the program from general to specific in a way that provides coherence, in order to achieve horizontal integration in the program.

5. It would be appropriate to add a skills-application exercise in the form of speculum insertion and smear collection to the program, so that this practice, carried out in the presence of a faculty member, is evaluated with a certain contribution to the examination.

6. It would be appropriate for every Thursday between 15:00-17:00 to be designated in the program as a Management/Coordination Hour, to be allocated to EBM and similar practices.
