Meeting Minutes

Venue	Dean's Office Building, Meeting Hall A

DECISIONS

The meeting of the Süleyman Demirel University Faculty of Medicine Student Council (SDÜ-TFÖK) was held on 6 April 2022 under the chairmanship of Muhammet Emin AĞIR, in Meeting Hall A of the Dean's Office Building, with the participation of the commission members.

At the meeting:

1. Since no progress had been made on the previously raised issue of "high canteen prices and insufficient facilities," it was proposed that this be brought back onto the agenda; in addition, it was proposed that the empty area near the Dean's-Office-side entrance of the canteen be turned into canteen space, and students also observed and reported that the tables/chairs were insufficient.
2. The previously raised request to replace the tables in the large study halls with shorter tables was renewed, with the proposal that the lower parts of the table legs be cut down (to match the height of the tables in the other study halls) to make them suitable for use.
3. It was proposed that the post-committee feedback system used before the pandemic be reactivated.
4. The need to create a logo for our Faculty was raised (it was noted that the Faculty of Dentistry already has its own logo, and it was considered that there would be no objection to creating a logo for our Faculty).
5. Consensus was reached on the need to provide, specifically for intern doctors, lunchtime training sessions in the lecture halls on cases that are important for their medical careers and that they will frequently encounter. It was agreed that this matter be presented as a proposal to the Dean's Office so that it would be discussed promptly by the relevant boards and implemented under a program.
6. Based on student feedback, a proposal was submitted for the diversification and improved efficiency of the Professional Skills Practices to be opened for discussion at the relevant Board.
7. The problem of the lack of a sufficient and widespread network of electrical outlets for charging computers or phones in all the study halls within our Faculty was discussed. A proposal was submitted to increase the number of outlets using extension cords and to enable access to electricity from many more tables.
8. Our Faculty's students need a food and drink vending machine in the lecture-hall area. The company that supplies vending machines to the faculties was contacted regarding this matter. It was learned that, with the approval of the Finance Unit, it may be possible to relocate low-usage vending machines from elsewhere within the university. A proposal was submitted for the Faculty Secretariat to hold the necessary discussions.
9. It is known that the plot of land within our university's boundaries connecting the Çünür neighborhood and our faculties is not intended for walking purposes. However, it is heavily used by students for this purpose. Therefore, a proposal was made — with our Dean's approval — for a walking path to be created in that area, even without a formal project, and for this to be forwarded to the Rectorate.
10. Our Dean, Prof. Dr. Alim KOŞAR, and our Vice Dean, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Kanat GÜLLE, attended the meeting upon our invitation; the Council's requests were evaluated with them, and information was provided about our Council.
